IMAC Denmark has the pleasure to invite you to the third Nordic Championships in IMAC. Classes to be flown are; Basic, Sportsman, Intermediate and Freestyle. In addition to the known sequences there will be unknown sequences in the Sportsman and Intermediate classes.

1.1 General info

Rules to be used are the latest version of AMA Competition Regulations, Radio Control Scale Aerobatics, as published in the rules section on the IMAC website, www.mini-iac.com.

(Except for sections 5.1, 5.2 and 5.3, see 1.5 in this document)

The IMAC 2011 known sequences will be the "known".

The Nordic Championship will be official as soon as one round (2 sequences known) is completed in each class (one sequence Freestyle).

1.1.1 Location and time

The Nordic Championship will be hosted by IMAC Denmark, and takes place at Grenaa Modelflyveklub (Link to map <http://map.krak.dk/m/ID4SW>), June 2nd to June 5th 2011. Practice times to be announced in Bulletin 1.0. The airfield is a grass-strip. The airspace will be changed during the day to avoid the sun. Map and driving directions to the competition site will follow in Bulletin 1.0.

1.1.2 Participating teams

Invitations have been sent to the following countries: Denmark, Finland, Norway, Iceland and Sweden. The invited countries are welcome to register a maximum of three (3) pilots in each of the above mentioned competition classes. A national team can therefore consist of a maximum of twelve (12) pilots.

1.2 Preliminary schedule

Wednesday June 1st	Pre-registration and practice.
Thursday June 2nd	Final registration and welcome. Known all classes (not Freestyle).
Friday June 3rd	Known all classes, 1 round Freestyle.
Saturday June 4th	Distribution of unknowns Sportsman and Intermediate. Known all classes. Unknown Sportsman and Intermediate. Freestyle.
Sunday June 5th	Formal banquet and award ceremony. Only to be used if the Nordic championship not yet have been official, see 1.1.

1.3 Radio frequencies

Channel 60 (35,000 MHz) through channel 82 and 2,4 GHz is approved for radio-controlled aircraft in Denmark.

1.4 Radio impound

There will be NO radio impound during official practice and competition. It is the responsibility of every pilot to be aware of "his/hers" channel and to use frequency-pins.

1.5 Sound check

Most of the Nordic countries are more noise sensitive than USA. Therefore the on ground sound limits published in the abovementioned rules (Section 5.1) are not applicable. The rules regarding the in-flight judging criteria (Section 5.4) will be used and in effect.

Any further restrictions (if required by local regulations) will be announced in bulletin 1.0.

1.6 Judges

We kindly invite the participating countries to nominate a maximum of two (2) judges for service at the championships.

The hosting federation –Denmark, will accommodate our invitee judges at or nearby the airfield.

Judges will be announced in bulletin 1.0.

Chief Judge and head of the competition judging and rules committee will be announced in Bulletin 1.0.

2.0 Accommodation

There will be on-site camping facilities. Nearby accommodation is possible at <http://www.danhostelgrenaa.dk/> it's only five (5) minutes by car.

Further information regarding accommodation on and off site will be announced in bulletin 1.0.

3.0 Entry fee and registration

The entry fee, registration procedure and day of final registration will be announced in bulletin 1.0.

4.0 Language

The official language for the Nordic Championship will be English.

5.0 Web Page

There will be a separate section/link available for the Nordic Championship on the Danish IMAC-website, www.mini-iac.dk no later than January 1st 2011.
